Some Term 1 highlights include:

- Swimming Week. Our Reception to year 5 students enjoyed a very successful week at swimming. I have had many excited students come and speak to me about what they can now do in the pool. Well done.
- Year 6/7 Aquatics including sailing, surfing, kayaking and snorkelling at West Lakes.
- Consolidating our uninterrupted Numeracy Block comprising a mental routine, explicit teaching of mathematical strategies and reflection.
- Implementation of a Literacy Focus Block, with a particular emphasis on the explicit teaching of strategies in Guided Reading.
- Our School Acquaintance Night and AGM were extremely well attended.

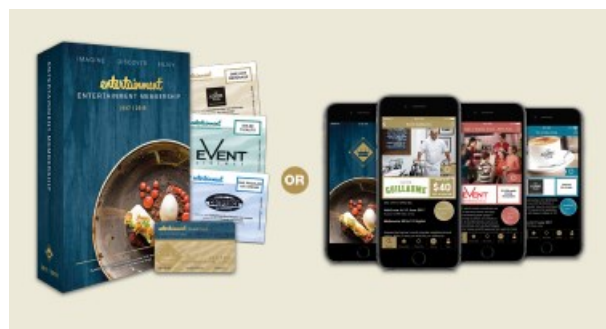
