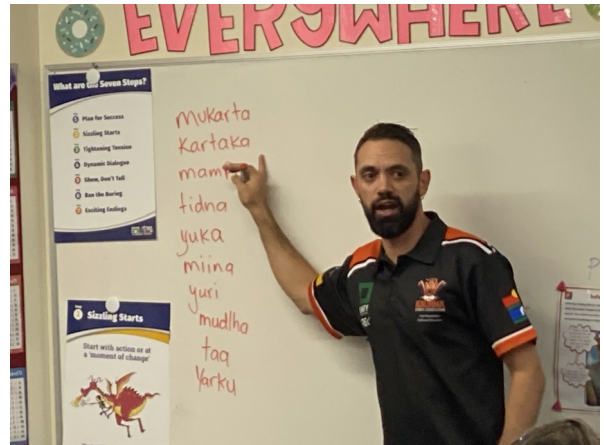

Grand Opening of our new swings

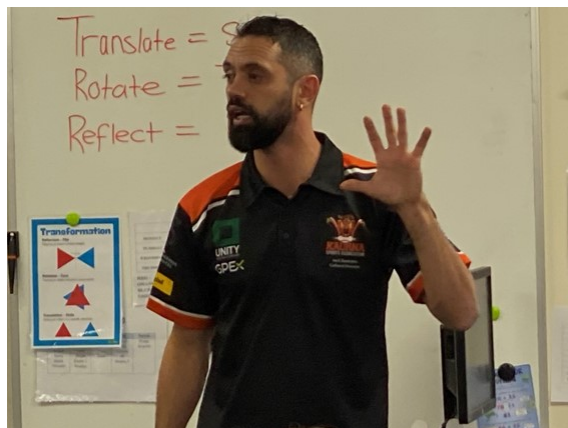
The weather finally stayed sunny enough for our concrete edges to be completed and our swings opened last Friday. See inside for more details.

Kaurna Language

Late last term, we were fortunate enough to have Kaurna community leader Jack Kanya Buckskin visit our Year 5/6/7 classes. Our school is familiar with Jack through his cultural instruction across our school over past years. This time it was a two-part session, with the first part focusing on student questions around issues raised by Reconciliation Week. Jack gave his unique voice to topics such as the Stolen Generation, what constitutes Aboriginality, and contemporary Kaurna life. We even had time for a chat about the best football teams!



The second part of the session supported our language curriculum, which is Kaurna. As a fluent speaker and experienced teacher, Jack taught a fantastic grammar activity around plural suffixes which everyone enjoyed immensely and which greatly enhanced our learning.



Lessons spent learning from Kaurna custodians are a vital part of our cross-curriculum priorities, and are irreplaceable opportunities to engage with our country's custodians and their knowledge. The students had an amazing time and we are all grateful for the sessions.

Numicon in Yaitya

Numicon is a system of flat plastic shapes with holes in, with each shape representing a number from one to 10. Each number has its own colour.

The aim of Numicon is to make numbers real for children through them being able to see and touch them. It also has a multi-sensory approach that's known to help learning.

- Develops fluency by using a visual, practical approach to build conceptual understanding and fluent recall.
- Provides step-by-step, hands-on activities that teach problem solving in real-life contexts.

The group then came up with a few guidelines of use and presented these at Assembly to the rest of students. Thank you to Bengi, Nevaeh, Verity, Willow, Ereelee and Emily for bravely speaking up at Assembly to share our suggestions of use.



3 lines - 1 shared, 1 Junior and 1 Primary



Crowds were eagerly awaiting their turn



Some needed a bit of a push to get started



Lots of fun was had by the students

Here are the student forum recommendations for safe swing use.

3 separate lines, lined up waiting behind the concrete edging - 1 Single Swing = Junior Primary, 1 Single Swing = Primary and the other Round Swing (**Maximum 2 people** at a time) shared year levels.

Enter from the front and exit from the back (concrete edging marked Green = Enter, Red = Exit)

Can have a helper to get you started but then it is up to swinger to be responsible for their own swing.

Take it in turns, no pushing in or letting in others into the line and wait patiently.

20 swings ONLY - when your turn is up, hop off straight away.

For Safety =

NO WALKING in front of the swings while they are being used

NO PUSHING others (unless it's to get them started)

NO STANDING on the swing seats

NO CLIMBING up the frame

NO JUMPING off of the swing

NO SWINGING swings into each other

Random Acts of Kindness Awards

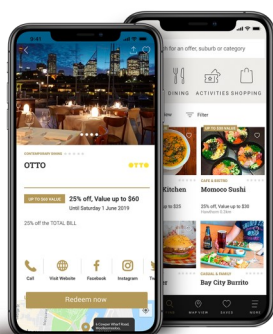
ALL Staff and Students are being encouraged to acknowledge any person they catch carrying out an act of kindness without being asked or instructed to do so.
