COVID update

Late last term, the State Government began to ease some restrictions being imposed on all South Australians due to the pandemic.

However, as we have seen in recent weeks in Victoria and New South Wales, complacency against the virus is our biggest ongoing problem and breakouts are possible. Consequently, vigilance and caution continue to guide our decision-making in ensuring our students, staff and families remain safe and healthy.

As a result Governing Council has made the decision to postpone Sports Day as the updated restrictions impact parent engagement in the day. We hope by postponing the day we have a higher chance of an unrestricted event.

We are scheduling a Fun Run event for students this term, however this will be a closed event with no spectators.

It is timely to remember the measures we already have in place.

- Parents and families are asked not to enter the classrooms.
- A hand washing regime will continue to be promoted and we ensure classes have ready access to hand sanitizer.
- Extra cleaning measures are in place and high touch surfaces are being cleaned and disinfected regularly.
- As always, please be vigilant about children who show any sign of illness, being kept at home.

We appreciate your ongoing support in ensuring that our school routines and daily schedules continue to operate as normal as possible during these challenging times.

- Please remember to be courteous at all times.






Mrs Bowler's class
