The Department's Same First Day initiative supports all children and families in the Salisbury Partnership starting preschool and school in 2021.

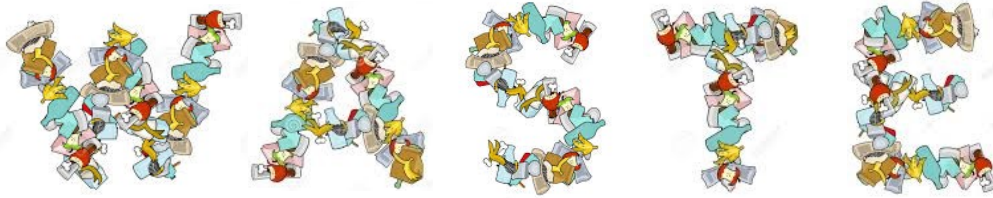
Individual preschools and schools will have transition visits on the same day, at the same time.
