Fun Run Highest Fundraisers

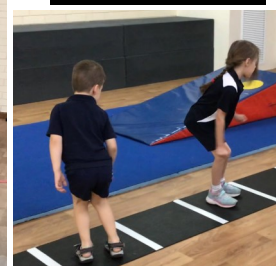

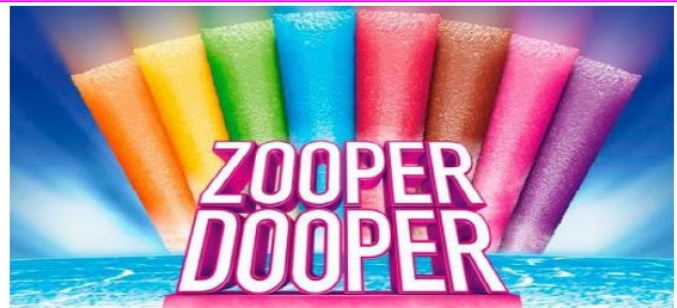
Dental Van
