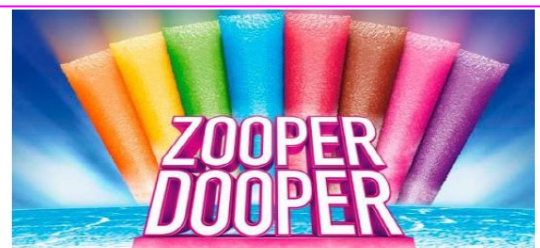
School Card 2021
