Driving Safety

We have observed parents parking on the school staff carpark driveways to drop off and pick up children. Please note this is not only illegal, it restricts access in and out of the carpark, and it is a risk to student safety. Please park safely and legally within the surrounding school streets.

Please observe school zone speed limits and take extra care when dropping off and picking up your children at school. To avoid accidents it's important for parents to follow safety rules.

Many schools have drop-off zones, taxi zones, parking and u-turns to maintain a safe and orderly traffic flow.

Safety instructions include:

- observing school speed limits - there's a 25 km zone around schools when children are present
- not parking in no standing zones or across school entrances
- respecting local neighbours and their right to access their driveways
- not double parking
- ensuring that children exit their car onto the footpath.

In addition, if your child rides a bike, scooter or skateboard to school, please ensure they are familiar with the road rules and travel to school safely obeying road rules along the way.



Materials and Services Charge

The Materials and Services Charge (MSC) for 2022 will be \$280.00. The voting slips for the 2022 MSC have been counted, with the result being 26 in favour and 8 no. The fees have not increased from last year.

Uniform Orders and pick up for 2022

If you have submitted a uniform order for 2022, you will be able to collect from the school front office and make any outstanding payments on the following dates:



Thursday 27th January 11:30am - 2:30pm

Friday 28th January 9:00am - 1:00pm

Alternatively orders can be collected once Term 1 commences on Monday 31st January.

For uniform requirements throughout the year please note that orders are placed with the supplier approximately weeks 2, 5 & 8 of term depending on demand. Orders generally take around 2 weeks to be delivered.

Uniform pricing will increase by \$0.50c per garment in 2022, up to date pricing information can be found on the SkoolBag app and information is also available in the front office. Order forms are available from the front office and payment is required prior to ordering. We do not keep stock of uniforms (with the exception of hats) however sizing details and samples are available to view and try on at the front office.

Online applications and School Card information will be available online at www.sa.gov.au in January 2022 providing information on Eligibility, Income Limits and How to Apply.

Paper copies will also be available from the school front office early in Term 1 if required. If you need assistance, please see front office staff or phone the School Card information section on 1800 672 758.
