School FEES

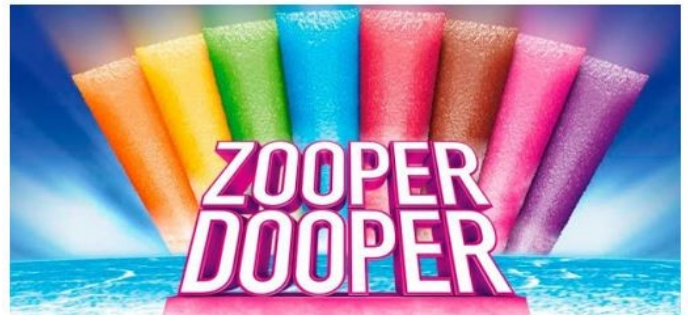
