National Reconciliation Week



We have celebrated and recognised National Sorry Day on May 26th and National Reconciliation Week from Tuesday 27th of May to Tuesday 3rd of June.

Students and staff were involved in various activities to learn about and celebrate culture and National Reconciliation Week. These include:

- "Our path to Reconciliation" display - Each class worked on their own footprints for a whole school display. Each student put a message of reconciliation on their footprint to represent the steps we can take toward authentic reconciliation.
- Damper tasting - Some of our older Aboriginal students, along with student leaders, baked some lemon myrtle damper for our students to have samples.

- Leadership Reading - Our leadership team has been visiting classes to do readings with students.
- 'Rec in the West' excursion- Mr Hughes took a group of our Aboriginal students to a Reconciliation Week event at Tauondi College in Port Adelaide. Students were engaged in cultural experiences and had a chance to talk to local community members.
