- Help create initiatives that strengthen our school community.

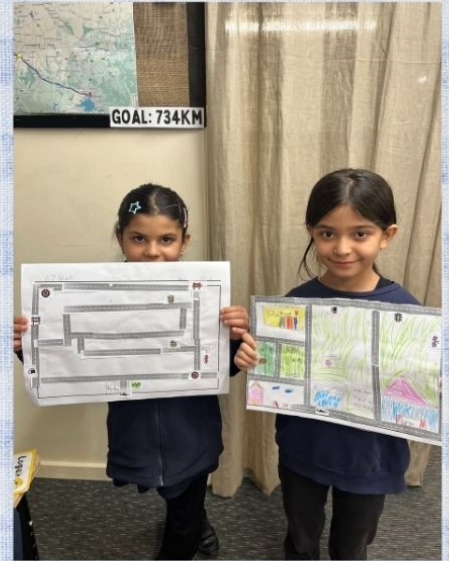
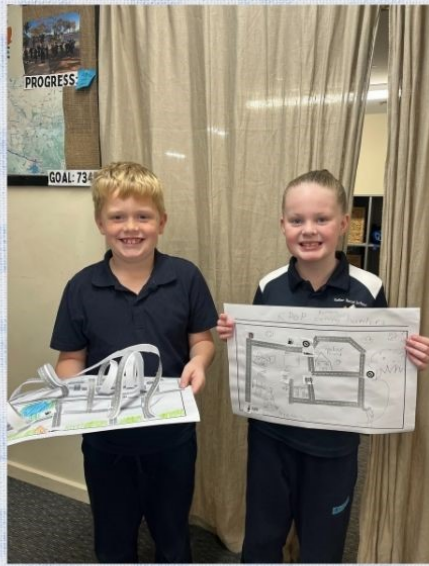
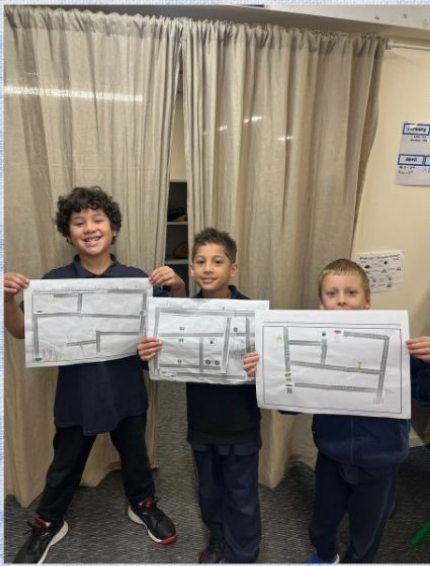
