New SA Curriculum

As part of our ongoing work with the new South Australian Curriculum, our school is placing a strong focus on **dispositional learning**—developing the habits and attitudes that support successful learning. In Numeracy, this means helping students build **Resilience, Reflectiveness, and Resourcefulness**. You may hear your child talking about these concepts in class. We are encouraging students to persist when learning feels challenging (Resilience), think about their strategies and learning (Reflectiveness), and use a range of tools and approaches to solve problems (Resourcefulness). We invite families to support this at home by asking simple, curiosity-building questions such as:

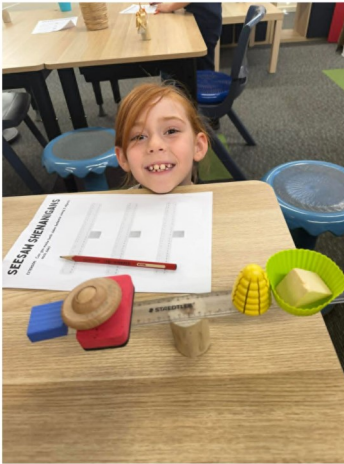
~ How did you solve that problem?

~ What did you do when it got tricky?

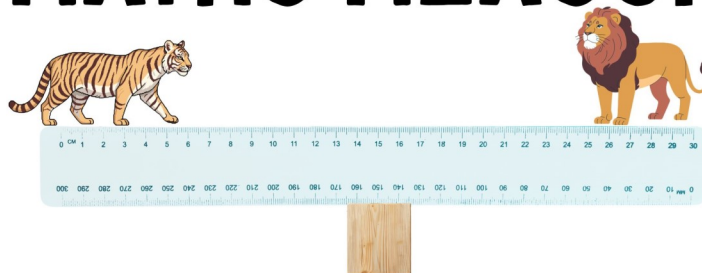
~ Is there another way you could try?

TUTA 5 MATHS MEASUREMENT



In our class we have been exploring measurement using non-routine tasks. This means that our problem can't be solved straight away using a familiar method or rule. We need to think more deeply, make connections, and try different strategies to find a solution.



In this task we were trying our best to make our ruler measurement scales balance using different objects around the room. Our biggest challenge was making it balance with 3 objects on each side!

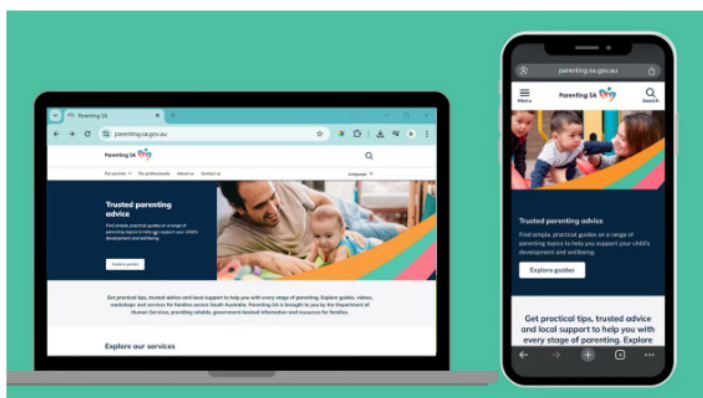
