### Morning transitions

If your child is finding drop-off tricky, here are a few gentle reminders that can help: Talk through the drop-off process the night before and again on the way to school so your child knows exactly what to expect. Keep goodbyes calm, positive and brief. Avoid lingering — a confident, quick goodbye is often best. Reassure your child that their teacher will take care of them and that you will see them in the afternoon. Some children have a small photo of their parent or a comfort item that helps with the tricky moments when they feel they are missing a loved one. Looking at the photo or holding the keepsake can provide the connection and comfort they are seeking.

### Winter weather

As the days become colder and children are wearing more layers, please check that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name. This makes it easier to quickly return lost items.

If it is raining at drop off time please ask your child to go directly to breakfast club and staff will redirect them to classes from there.

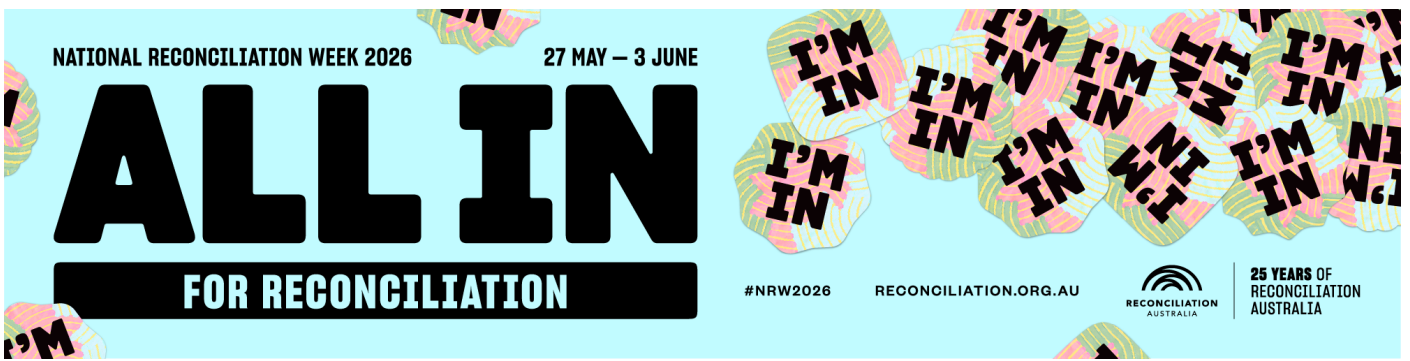
### Pupil Free Day



### Caregiver and Emergency Contacts

Please ensure that all contact details are kept up to date via the front office. This can be done in person, by phoning us on 8258 3842 or emailing [dl.0632.info@schools.sa.edu.au](mailto:dl.0632.info@schools.sa.edu.au).

It is important to remember that anyone other than parent/caregivers picking up children outside of the normal finishing time must be listed as an emergency contact or the school notified in advance (for a once off collection). If this is not completed the student will be required to remain at school until the parent/caregiver can be contacted. Please note they may be asked for photo identification upon requesting student collection.

If you are unsure who is listed in your emergency contacts please contact the school. Persons listed have authority to pick up your child/ren so it is important to keep them up to date.
